



THEME: Forward Passing



KEY

- goal
- cone
- team 1
- team 2
- ball
- ball movement
- player movement



- HOW TO PLAY**
- Penalty area divided into 4 zones. Two goals are placed on baselines in two outer zones. Each team member has a separate zone to start off
 - Players passing/receiving the ball among their teammates. No more than two players is allowed to be in one zone and there should not be the players from the same team!

- PROGRESSIONS**
- For team in possession is allowed no more than two players in one zone.
 - Team on possession is awarded 2 points for passing forward from zone 1 to zone 2 and so on.
 - If you played across two zones and score 3 points awarded

- DECISIONS AND CHALLENGES WITHIN THE GAME**
- Recognise the opportunity to pass forward
 - Recognise space to be able to receive forward pass
 - What can I do with the ball if there is no options to pass forward?
 - When is the right time to pass the ball forward?
 - What type of passes may help us moving forward?

TASK	Ball can be play across two zones	Ball cannot be played across two zones
EQUIPMENT	Use one size football	Vary size of footballs
